Passage: Ephesians 5:21-33

Big Problem: Marriage and a fight for independence work against each other.

## Points of Impact:

- Key Words
  - o "Submit" to one another out of reverence to Christ." (Verse 21)
  - o "Submit (MELD) to your husbands as unto the LORD." (Verse 22)
  - o "Love your wives as Christ loved the Church." (Verse 25)
    - "...Head of his wife as Christ is head of the church. He is the savior of His body, the church." (Verse 23)
    - "In the same way, husbands ought to love their wives as they love their own bodies...feeds and cares for it..." (Verse 28-29)
    - "...leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife...the two are united as one." (Verse 31)
  - o "Respect" (Verse 33)
