ACCOMODATIONS AND COST

How much does the retreat cost?

The cost per couple (husband and wife) is \$390. This includes two nights lodging, two dinners, two breakfasts, and one lunch.

- \$100 deposit is required to hold your place.
- Please make \$75 payments December 10, January 10, and February 10 and March 10 until balance is paid in full.
- Balance is due by March 10.

Are there any discounts?

If you pay in full by January 20, you will receive a \$10 discount and be entered into a drawing for a lakefront room.

What are the sleeping arrangements?

Each couple will stay in a hotel-style guest room. This will include two or three queen beds, private bath, sheets, towels, blankets, and pillows. (Beds are not pre-made.) Rooms do not include refrigerators, hair dryers, irons/ironing boards, or shampoo.

LOCATION AND SCHEDULE

Where is the conference located?

It is located on the shore of beautiful Lake Tahoe.

What time can we show up to check in on Friday?

Check in time begins at 4:00 pm. Friday afternoon. We do not have access to the building prior to 4:00 p.m. If you want to leave Sacramento earlier to beat traffic, please plan on sightseeing around the lake and then coming to the retreat location at 4:00 pm.

What time do Friday night activities begin?

Dinner will start at 6:00 p.m. with activities to follow. Buffet closes at 6:20 p.m.

Where will check-in be on Friday afternoon?

Our accommodations are located in the Tallac Center. To reach this location, drive into the parking lot, stay to the right, and drive all the way down the hill. You will see a welcome sign for our retreat in front of the building. Please note: there is no

permanent parking in front of the building. Luggage drop off will occur in front of the Tallac Center. Registration check-in will occur in the lobby of the Tallac Center.

What if we're not arriving until after dinner Friday evening?

If you are unable to arrive until late Friday evening, please inform us at the time of your registration. We will make an alternate check-in plan for you.

If we are unable to make it on Friday, can we check in on Saturday?

Yes. There will not be a reduction in cost if arriving Saturday morning. If you are planning on arriving Saturday morning, please inform us at the time of your registration. Details regarding an alternate check-in process will be provided to you.

What time will the conference end on Sunday?

Our Sunday morning general session will end around 10:30 am. All items must be out of your rooms prior to 11:00 am. We must be checked out of the Tallac Center by 12:00 pm.

REGISTRATION

Do we have to register online?

No, but we prefer online registration because it makes the process easier for you as well as for us. If you are unable to register online, please stop by in the courtyard before or after services on Sunday or visit Married Life when we are meeting in the Student Center between 9:30 am -10:45 am Sunday mornings.

What credit cards are accepted online?

MasterCard, Visa, Discover.

Can we pay with credit or debit card at the Information Kiosk?

No, cash or check only.

When is the last day to register?

The deadline for registering is Sunday, April 7, 2019. However, be sure to register as soon as possible to be sure rooms are available.

CAN WE BRING OUR CHILDREN? IS CHILDCARE AVAILABLE?

Please make plans for childcare at home. We love our kids, but it's important for you and your spouse to enjoy special time at Lake Tahoe without them.

PARKING

Onsite parking is limited and located at the top of the hill, just inside the main entrance. This consists of an outdoor parking lot and a covered parking garage. Registrants will be able to temporarily park in front of the conference center to unload luggage but will then have to move cars to the parking area. We will have a shuttle service between the parking area and the main building.

We encourage carpooling. However, we will not be coordinating carpooling.

FOOD AND DRINKS

What type of meals will be provided?

The Tallac Center Dining Hall provides delicious, well-balanced, cafeteria-style meals that will be served at 8:00 a.m., 12:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. Five meals will be provided throughout the weekend:

- Friday - Dinner
- Saturday - Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner
- Sunday - Breakfast

Is there a vegetarian or vegan option?

Vegetarian and vegan meal requests can be accommodated. These meal requests must be specified at the time of registration and there will be an additional \$5.00 charge.

Is there a gluten free option?

Zephyr Point cannot guarantee accommodation of other dietary requests such as gluten-free, dairy-free, low-sugar, low-carb, etc.

Can we opt out of the meal plan?

Sorry, no. Due to the budget constraints of the venue, the cost of registration includes all meals.

CLOTHING
