



EVERYONE NEEDS A MIRACLE

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John 5:1-9

Miracles reveal **God's heart** and His **love** for us.

What Do I See In This Miracle?

1. Our apparent **COMFORT** may keep us sick.

"One of the men lying there had been sick for thirty-eight years." (John 5:5)

2. Our **EXCUSES** don't keep Jesus from working in our lives.

"I can't, sir," the sick man said, "for I have no one to help me into the pool when the water is stirred up. While I am trying to get there, someone else always gets in ahead of me." (John 5:7)

3. Our **FIRST STEPS** after being changed are very important steps.

"Instantly, the man was healed! He rolled up the mat and began walking!" (John 5:9)

- Are we walking away from our "sick" friends?
- Are we walking towards them and telling them how they can be healed?

What Can I Do?

• Answer life's **PRIMARY** question.

Question 1: "Do I want to **GET WELL**?"

• Allow Jesus to be a part of your change **PROCESS**.

Question 2: "Can I change **BY MYSELF**?"

• Get up and do something with your **CHANGED LIFE**.

Question 3: "Do I want my life to **COUNT** for something?"

One last thought:

The Bible wasn't just written to tell stories about miracles. It was written so that miracles would lead you to a **CHANGED LIFE!**
