What are Life Groups?

It's in Life Groups that we meet and spend time with others walking at the side of Christ together to unpack the message from Sunday and pursue God's truth. Life is better in groups!

When and Where Do They Meet?

Life Groups meet on various nights of the week in homes throughout the community and on campus. Most evening groups meet from 7:00 pm to 8:30 pm.

How Long Do They Last?

Each Life Group session lasts 7 to 9 weeks. We have Fall, Winter & Spring sessions. At the end of each session you will have the choice of staying in the same group, trying a new group or even taking a break. Most groups stay together throughout the entire year. Life Groups do not meet June through August.

What is the Required Commitment?

Joining a Life Group requires 8-week commitment to attend weekly meetings as well as doing the homework ahead of time. The commitment is the key to a strong Life Group. You have the first three weeks to attend the group to make sure it's a good fit for you.
